

Super Potato
Tokyo, Japan

Norihiro Shinya, after graduating with top honours from Meiji University, Department of Architecture, obtained the 1st Class Architect's license; then joined Super Potato in April 1987. He was involved in interior planning for Japanese domestic bars and restaurants, retail units, etc. The turning point was in 1998, where a renovation project for Grand Hyatt Singapore lobby, music bar, restaurant Mezza9, was the start of international hospitality interior designing career, mainly in the Asian market. With the success of an interior design for a buffet restaurant with a show kitchen, Café Too in Island Shangri-La, Hong Kong renovation design in 2001, he became the designer and manager for numerous projects all over Asia, India, the Middle East and USA. In Malaysia, Shinya has designed and managed a restaurant in Starhill, Kuala Lumpur and a Japanese restaurant in Shangri-La Hotel, Kuala Lumpur. Shinya is at present the Vice-President of Super Potato.

Adi Purnomo was born in Yogyakarta, Indonesia in 1968. He studied architecture at Gadjah Mada University. His career as an architect began with working in architectural firm PAI, Jakarta in 1994. In 2000 he established his own practice. From small house projects that formed the image of the practice, Mamostudio began to spread their works to a wider spectrum of larger residential developments, institutional and commercial buildings. Some of the houses he designed won awards from IAI (Indonesian Institute of Architects) in 2002, 2005, 2006 and 2008.

Laurence Loh is recognised as a leading conservation architect and cultural heritage expert in Malaysia and the Asia-Pacific region. His architectural practice of 35 years consistently delivers highly commended projects related to newly-built designs, as well as building conservation and planning. Increasingly, his practice facilitates the revitalisation of heritage sites through an integrated approach that incorporates various expertise through an interdisciplinary approach. Currently, he is the director of Think City Sdn Bhd, a company responsible for the dispersal of financial grants to catalyse neighbourhood regeneration and to facilitate cultural-mapping in the World Heritage Site of George Town; as well as other heritage-rich towns in Malaysia such as Kuala Lumpur and Johor Bahru.

Lim In Chong, known fondly as "Inch", is a Malaysian designer who was born in 1955, in the small town of Batu Pahat. Inch's design skills are honed through many years of practical experience and he sees Architecture, Interior and Landscape as part of the same continuum. Inch's works have achieved international success and have gained numerous awards in Japan, USA, UK, Singapore, Sri Lanka and here in Malaysia. Inch works at Inchscape Sdn Bhd and currently lives in Kuala Lumpur.

Yu Sing graduated from Institut Teknologi Bandung in 1999, he then, together with a college friend, established an architecture design studio. He has actively participated in various architectural competitions, many of which he has won. Since, he has been frequently invited to give public lectures, seminars and workshops by architecture colleges in Indonesia.

In 2008, answering his life long search for meaning, Yu Sing established Akonama, an independent architecture design studio that provides affordable designs for the middle and lower income families. He has also continuously been working with young apprentices and students catering to the dreams of middle and lower income families to have their own architect-designed houses. In the year 2009, Yu Sing published 'Mimpin Rumah Murah', a book of affordable houses.
