Art of Restoration of Derelict Heritage Buildings in World Heritage Site Penang, George Town Shophouse City - The Process, Outcome and Protection

Presentation Summary: The Penang Heritage Shophouse style is developed and its on-going transformation infused alongside the urban growth of the city of George Town, and its pattern as well as its usage, which evolves over the period of time. The talk will delve into the historic and economic background of the city and the application process of the World Heritage Site and the restoration examples.

Ar. Ooi Bok Kim graduated from the National Cheng Kung University in Tainan, Taiwan and the Welsh School of Architecture, University of Wales in United Kingdom.

He was a member of the team which prepared the dossier document for the submission to UNESCO for George Town to be inscribed as a World Heritage Site.

Ar Ooi is currently working as a Conservation Architect, providing consultation services for the restoration of historic heritage buildings, as well as for the culture, heritage preservation and developmental work.

Old (Play) Ground

In the restoration project of a Chinese shophouse in George Town, Penang, "You Le Yuen" was designed to be the home to the owner as well as part of his collection of vintage furniture, objects and arts which he had sourced through out the region.

As a designer astute to spatial inspiring projects, he approaches the project with sensitivity towards spatial and sustainability through adopting tectonics approach to regain historical and conservations narrative of Penang.

The result is overwhelmingly accepted both by owner and public alike. It sprus up conversational topics and encouragement for similar projects.
